Petition addressed to Hugh Lord, commanding officer in the Illinois, by Louis Viviat, trader of Kaskaskia, requesting an order for the seizure of Bacon's property for nonpayment of a debt of 600 livres. Executed at Kaskaskia. (lp.)

Petition addressed to Capt. Hugh Lord by Thomas Bentley, to whom Girrard Langlois of Prairie du Rocher owes 764 livres, 10 sols for various notes, and who refuses to pay. Executed at Kaskaskia. Followed by Lord's disposition of the suit to Barbeau, judge at Prairie du Rocher, given at Fort Gage on same day. (3pp. Misc. V-VII)
